SWIM ACROSS AMERICA IS A NATIONAL NON-PROFIT WHICH RAISES FUNDS THROUGH OPEN WATER SWIMS, CLINICS AND EVENTS FOR CANCER RESEARCH AND CLINICAL TRIALS. THE FUNDS STAY IN THE CITIES IN WHICH THEY ARE RAISED.

SINCE 1987, SWIM ACROSS AMERICA HAS RAISED OVER \$100 MILLION THROUGH 23 OPEN WATER SWIMMING AND OVER 100 POOL SWIM FUNDRAISING EVENTS.

SAA-Denver funds benefit three research projects at the Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at Children's Hospital Colorado.



- Dr. Michael Edwards is dedicated to building a Cancer Predisposition Program for pediatrics and will be developing a strong collaborative relationship with other pediatric cancer centers around the country to share and develop best practices in research and treatment for children with cancer predisposition syndromes. He will also work in concert with our adult oncology partners to continue life-span care for families affected by genetic predisposition syndromes.
- Dr. Allison L'Hotta is studying ways to help pediatric cancer patients recover from their treatment and the negative physical consequences of intensive therapies that may include surgery, radiation, and chemotherapy across months and years of treatment. She employs a mixed methods approach to studying and developing interventions to help children, adolescents, and young adults make more comprehensive and complete recovery after cancer therapy.
- Dr. Sandra Luna-Fineman will develop a more comprehensive program in retinoblastoma. She will participate in and lead clinical trials for children with retinoblastoma, provide more support to the families in education/learning, build adaptive programs for children who suffer blindness as a result of their cancer treatment, and better establish long-term follow-up programs.

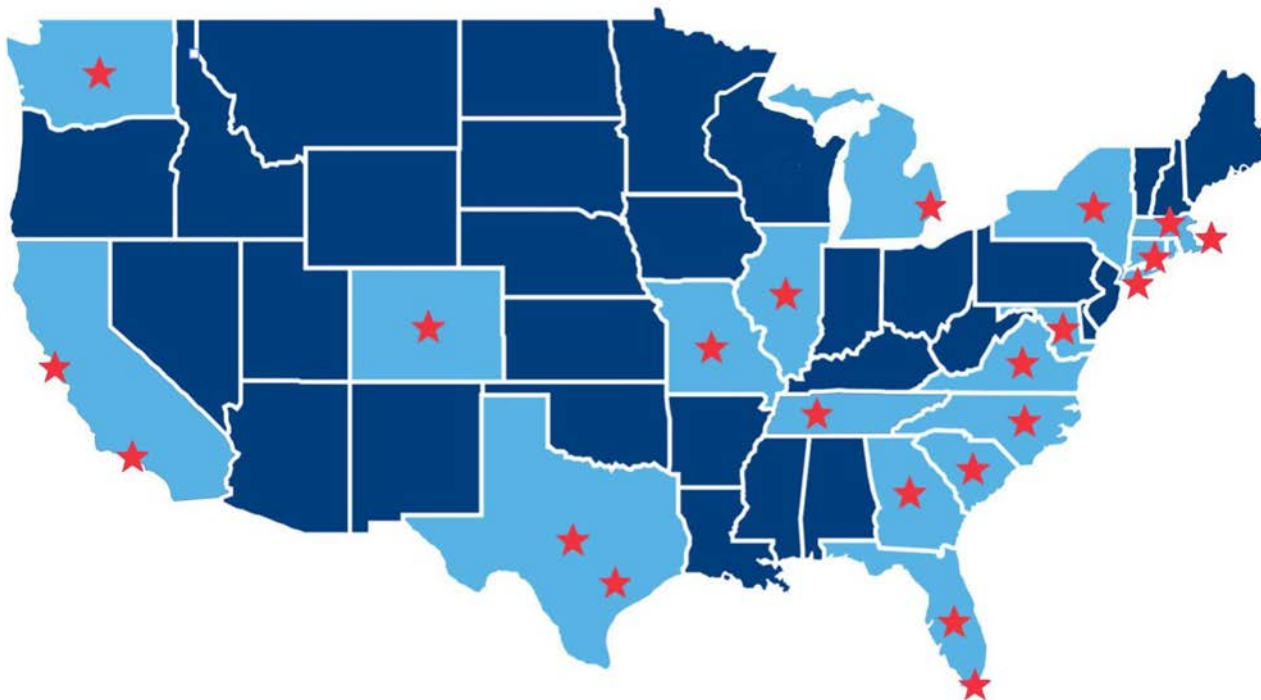
